

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

# VIPLAK

## Disclosing Agent

### 1. PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Viplak AF do BRASIL is used to show the presence of bacterial plaques with a reddish color. Composed of basic fuchsin, it has a greater power of staining and revealing bacterial plaque on teeth, even on apparently clean teeth. Due to its revealing action, Viplak favors oral hygiene instruction.

### 2. PRESENTATION

1 vial with 10ml of VIPLAK.

### 3. COMPOSITION

Basic Fuchsin; Ethyl Alcohol and Deionized Water.

### 4. INDICATION OF USE

Indicated to show bacterial plaque.

### 5. PRODUCT ACTION

VIPLAK gives the product greater power to stain bacterial plaque, on apparently clean teeth, in a color that contrasts with the teeth. This artifice not only facilitates the location of plaque, it also favors oral hygiene instruction.

### 6. CONSERVATION/STORAGE



STORE IN A DRY PLACE AT ROOM TEMPERATURE (15 TO 30°C).

### 7. INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE IN ENDODONTICS

#### 1. Topical application:

- Moisten the swab or cotton ball with VIPLAK and apply to all dental surfaces;
- Then make a mouthwash with water to remove the excess.

#### 2. Mouthwash:

- Place approximately 6ml of water in a glass, add 1ml (approximately 16 drops) of VIPLAK, rinse for 1 minute and dispense; Then rinse your mouth with water to remove excesses.

#### NOTE:

- All areas that become stained identify the presence of bacterial plaque, which must be removed by using a toothbrush and dental floss.
- VIPLAK can be used daily, preferably during the last tooth brushing.

### 8. CONTRAINDICATIONS

Contraindicated for people with reported sensitivity to any of the product's components.

### 9. WARNINGS

- Do not use expired expiration date;
- Keep out of the reach of children;
- Exclusive use of the dentist.

### 10. SPECIAL CARES

Avoid excessive inhalation of concentrated vapors. The use of protective glasses and gloves is recommended.

### 11. MANIPULATION

- When handling the product, the professional must wear protective gloves and goggles;
- Dispose of the product in accordance with current legislation in the country.
